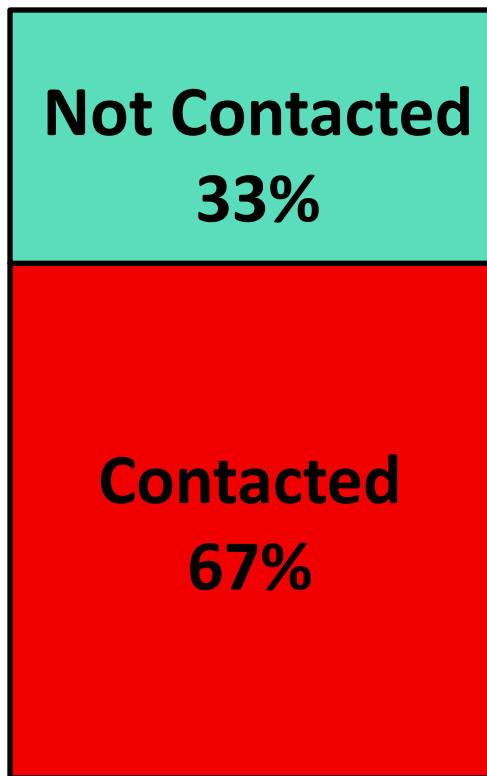


Caroline Petition

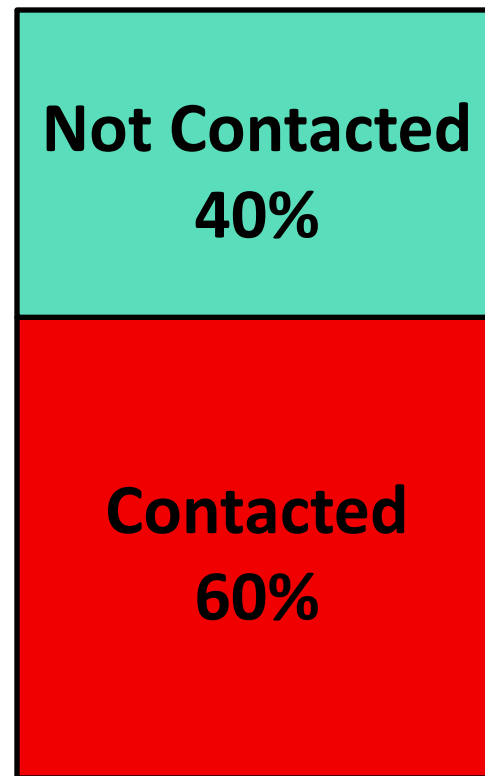

▶ **Petitioners contacted over half the households and people in the Town of Caroline.**



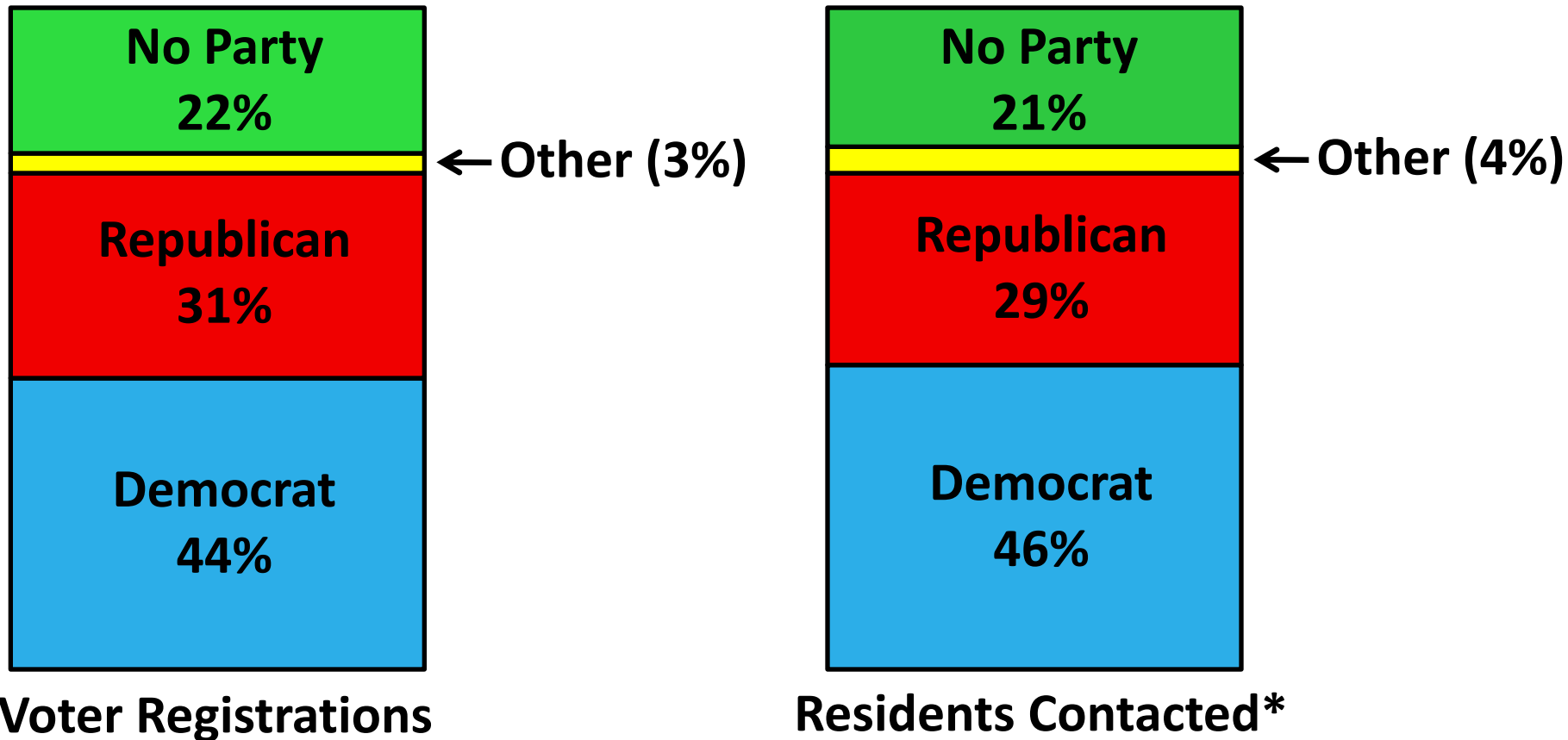
**Number of Households

18 and Over (2,591)***

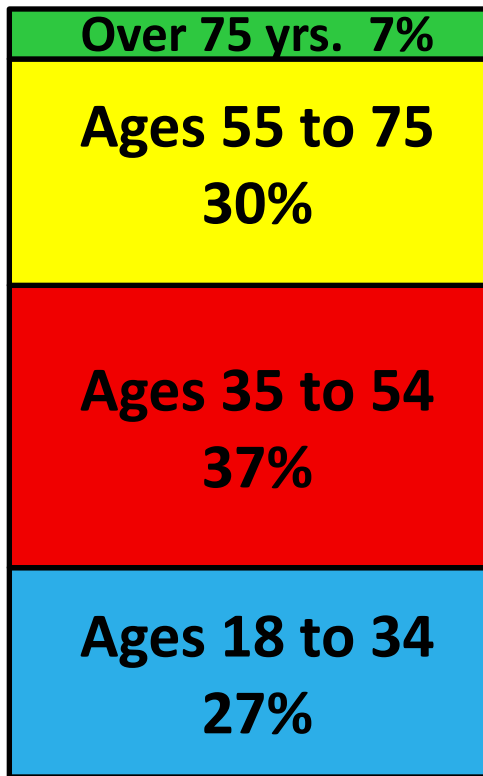

► **Residents contacted are representative of the political party affiliations in Caroline.**

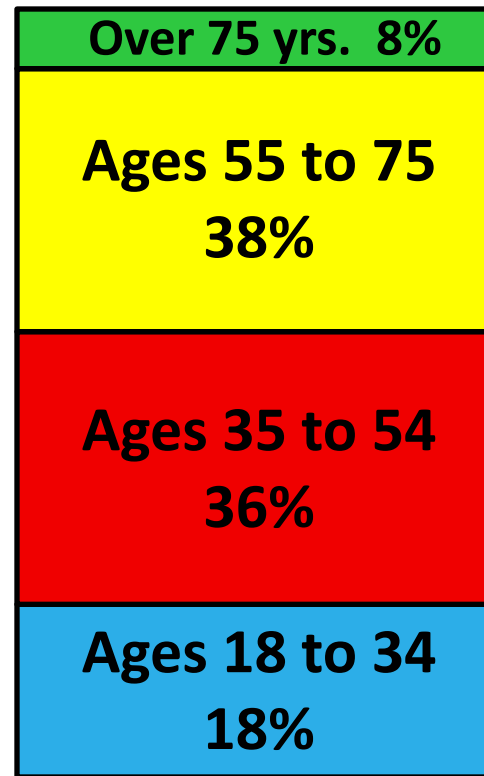


*Comparison is made for those people contacted for whom party affiliation is known.

► **Residents contacted are representative of the ages of Caroline residents.**



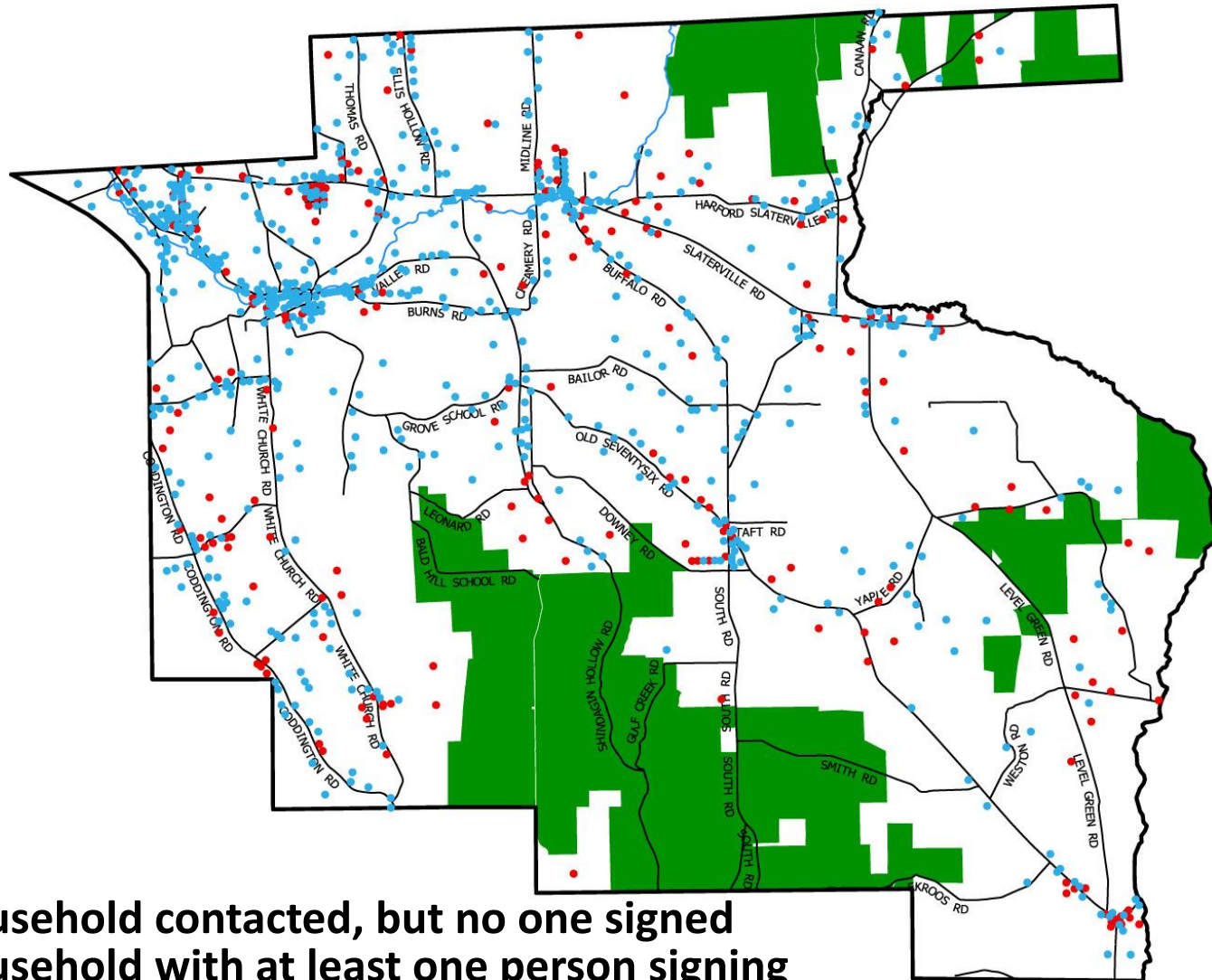
2010 Census



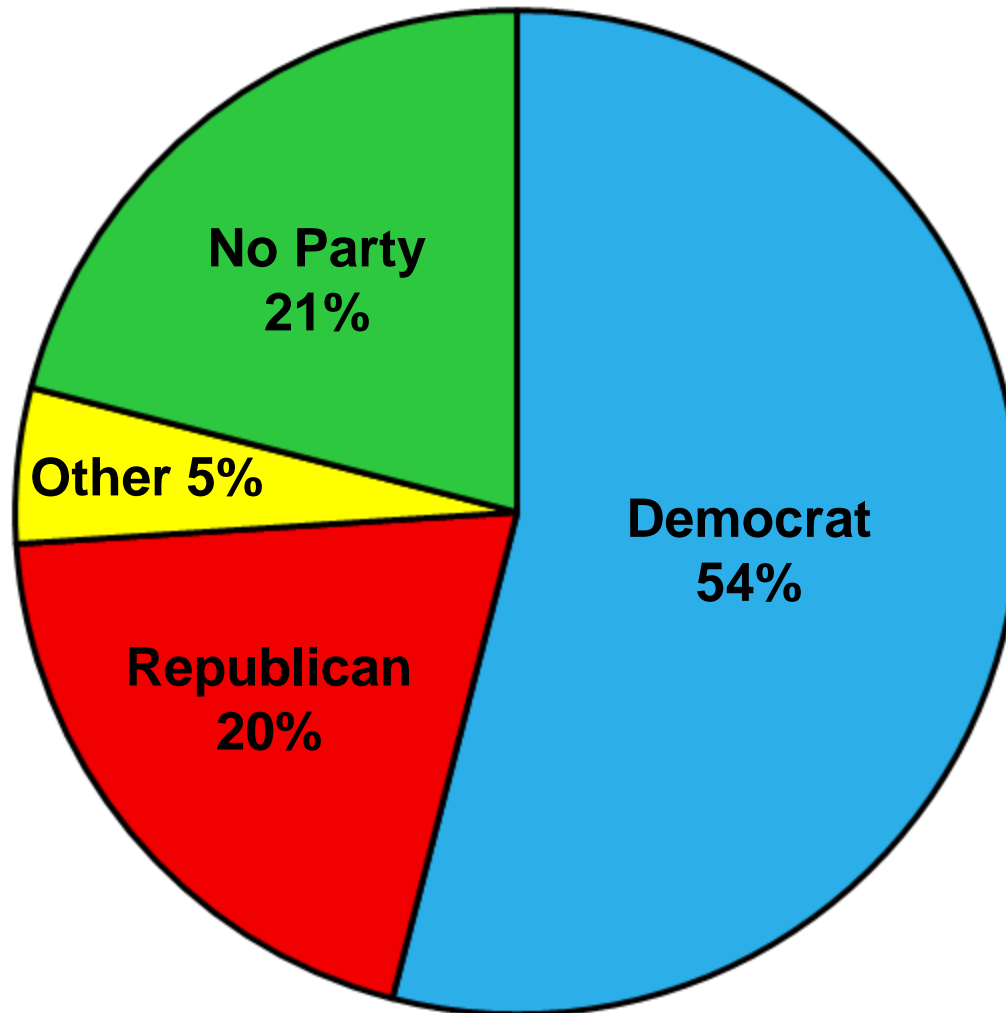
**Registered Voters

▶ Petition signers come from all over Caroline.

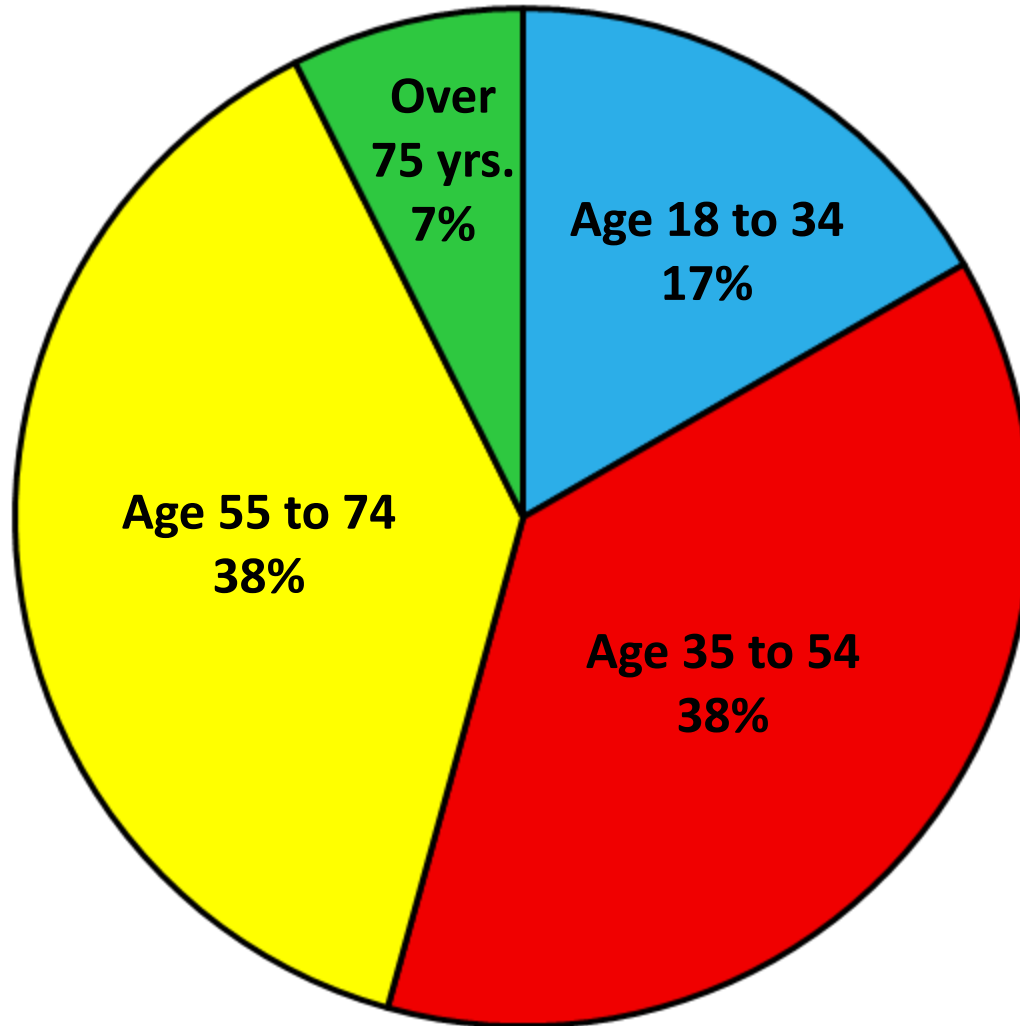


► **Petition signers are from all political parties.**



Political Party of Petition Signers

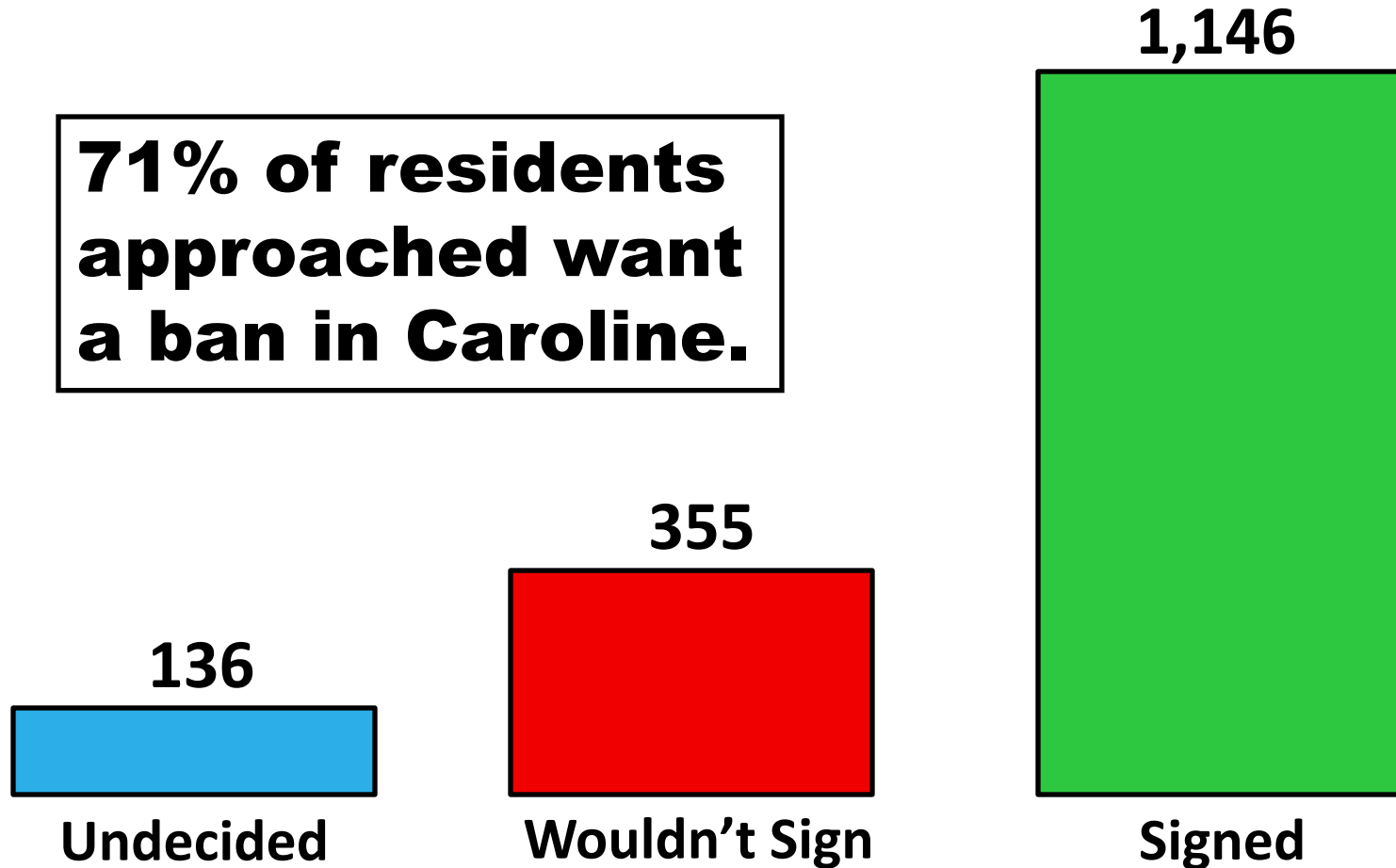
► **Petition signers are of all ages.**



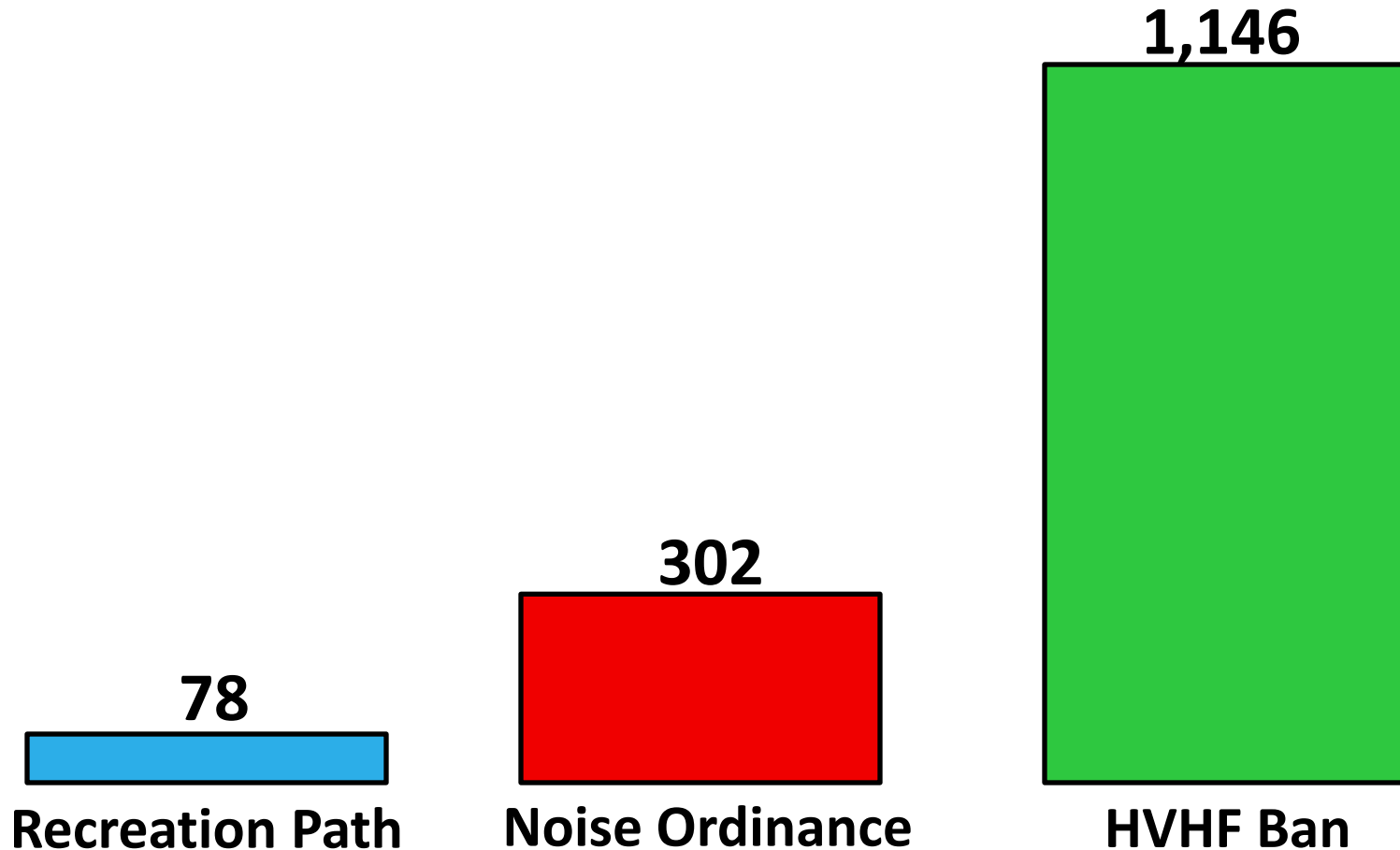
Ages of Petition Signers
